2019/20 Christmas Vacation Care Program

The Christmas Vacation Care Program is now open for bookings. **\$65 Early Bird Bookings** can be made by returning the completed form by **MONDAY 25 NOVEMBER BEFORE 6PM**. Ensure your booking has been received by calling the phone number below or emailing. Parents are required to complete an OSHC Enrolment Form before their child/ren are able to attend Vacation Care.

NB: Rate is \$70 per day - \$65 per day Early Bird prior to 6pm on Monday 25 November.

Breakfast, morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea are included in the daily fee. Some activities, foods and excursions incur additional costs as per Vacation Care Program over page.

IMPORTANT PARENT NOTICE REGARDING CANCELLATIONS

Cancellation of bookings for Vacation Care must be made **four (4)** business days prior to the session starting, or a fee, equal to the fee for that session (including additional costs) will be charged. Cancellations emailed through on weekends, public holidays or during school closures **will not** be counted as part of the four (4) days' notice. For example: cancellation of booked day Thursday - no fee will be charged if notice is given on the previous Friday.

Select bookings carefully, as substituting of booked days will not be accepted unless it is within the above timeframe, i.e. cancelling and rebooking.

Operating hours for Vacation Care are regular 12 hours between 6am to 6pm - a 15-minute grace period will be given to parents who pick up their child/children after 6pm. Parents/ carers who pick up their child/children after 6:15pm will incur a late fee of \$20 per 15 minutes or part thereof.

Parents/ carers are required to sign the attached permission form and tick for each excursion their children are enrolled.

OSHC reserves the right to change the program without notice if required. Parents will be notified on arrival of any changes.

NB: What to bring and wear - **HAT (children will wear VC yellow bucket hats for excursions only), walking shoes where appropriate and clothes that provide cover from the sun** - please apply sunscreen before attending (we will reapply). Provide your own sunscreen if your child has an allergy.

Drills are carried out during every Vacation Care period. These will be advertised prior to the date. Advertising will also appear on the Vacation Care program for your convenience.

While educators will make every endeavour to encourage all children to complete craft and activities on the program, sometimes children do not choose to participate. We encourage students to participate and complete tasks, however, we will provide them with other activities and opportunities of interest if required.
