Tuition and boarding fees are charged by the semester. There are two semesters per year. The payment of all school fees is required by the due date (first day of each semester). Late payment will incur an administration fee of \$240.

- Semester 1 fees are payable by 24 January 2022 (early payment discount date is 17 January)
- Semester 2 fees are payable by 11 July 2022 (early payment discount date is 04 July)

A discount of \$120 per semester on both tuition and boarding fees will apply if payment is received by 3.30pm one week prior to the due date. Early payment discount dates are outlined above.

Tuition Fees are set by the School Board annually. All fees tuition and non-tuition are subject to review.

Payment can be made by cheque, cash or EFTPOS. For other payment methods, refer to the Fees Statement. Credit card payments made via Parent Lounge are free of surcharge. Credit card surcharge applies for all other credit card payments.

Enrolment Application Fee

The School requires a non-refundable application fee of \$110.00AUD when lodging an Enrolment Application Form for your child.

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SIBLING DISCOUNT

The Board of Trustees has approved the following discounts on tuition fees:

- For the second student from one family attending the School concurrently, 5%
- For third and subsequent students from one family attending the School concurrently, 10%
- Where a family has boys at IGS and girls at IGGs concurrently, a further 3.5%

LATE PAYMENT FEE

Where accounts are not paid by the due date, a late payment administration fee of \$240 per semester will be charged. Allowance should be made for external agencies' processing time. Where accounts are referred to a collection agency, the agency costs will be added to the amount outstanding.

BOARD OF TRUSTEES FEE PAYMENT POLICY

Payment of all fees by the due date is a condition of continued attendance at the School and the provision of education services. Failure to pay fees as and when due may lead to the withdrawal of education services and the removal of the student from the School. The School also reserves the right to withhold student report cards and/or statements of reference if accounts remain overdue at the end of the term/semester.

Where fees are not paid by the due date, payment arrangements are available, however, such payments can only be made by direct bank debit authority. No other payment arrangements are acceptable.

ITEMS NOT INCLUDED IN THE TUITION FEES

Additional fees are payable on a user-pays basis for some activities. These fees are payable via Parent Lounge which is accessible via the School's website. Fees will be charged to an account at the end of each term and are due for payment on the due date for tuition fees.

Via website (Parent Lounge):

- Co-curricular activities
- Camps
- Excursions and visitor activities (any excess not covered by tuition fee)
- Hospitality Levy, Years 9 to 12
- Fees for Special Programs
- Non QGSSSA/Andrews Cup/Britton Shield sports participation and travel

Charged to account:

- Daily bus to and from school and for special events
- Instrumental Hire Scheme is available
- Textbook Hire Scheme for Years 7 to 12
- Other incidental costs incurred by the School

Other Items:

- Excess printing and photocopying charges (i.e. over and above the allocations of \$20 per year for Prep to Year 3, \$60 per year for Years 4 to 12, except Graphics students at \$100 per year)
- Private lessons for singing, music, speech and drama, tennis (invoiced directly by tutor/coach).

Expenditure incurred by boarders such as personal items, telephone, medical, travel and some excursions will be charged to boarders' accounts or by agreement with parents. A boarder activity levy of \$750 per annum for full-time boarders will be charged by semester; semester 1 - \$500 and Semester 2 - \$250. The levy covers a camp, additional weekend activities and excursions. Weekly boarders will incur a \$50 per semester activity levy.

CAPITAL LEVY (non-tax deductible)

A compulsory capital levy of \$150 per family per Semester is included on each term's fees account. This levy will directly support the capital works program of the School.

VOLUNTARY BUILDING FUND (tax deductible)

A voluntary building fund of \$50 or more can be donated to the School. This contribution to the building fund enables voting rights in a single cycle of the Board of Trustees reconstitution. Current cycle April 2021 - April 2025.

STUDENT ACCIDENT INSURANCE

The School pays the premium for student insurance through AON Australia. The current brochure is available on request. It details items covered by the policy. Enrolled students are covered for the year.

ENROLMENT APPLICATION FEE

All applications for entry into the School incur a \$110 (including GST) application fee which covers processing costs. This fee is non-refundable and does not guarantee a place in the School.

CONFIRMATION FEE*

Acceptance of the offer of a place in the School must be accompanied by a confirmation fee: \$500 for students in Prep to Year 12. The confirmation fee is non-refundable.

*In cases of Student visa refusal, the confirmation fee will be considered in any refund calculation. See the International Student Refund Policy on our website.

NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL (DOMESTIC & INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS)

The School commits resources based on confirmed enrolments. Once a student has been enrolled in the School, it is essential that parents/guardians provide **one full term's notice** if they are intending to withdraw a student from the school. If a parent/guardian is intending to withdraw a student, then a full term's notice must be sent in writing to the Principal & CEO. Failure to do so will result in a full term's tuition fees being charged in lieu of this notice.

Where a student is withdrawing at the end of each current term, written withdrawal is required at the beginning of that term to avoid being charged for the next term's tuition fees. The required dates are as follows:

- *Withdrawal at the end of Term 1 2022 will need to be received by 27 January 2022.*
- *Withdrawal at the end of Term 2 2022 - by 19 April 2022; and*
- *Withdrawal at the end of Term 3 2022 - by 12 July 2022,*

For all students not returning in 2023 - Term 4 Withdrawal:

- *written notice of withdrawal is required by 31 October 2022 otherwise one half-term's fees will be payable for 2023, 1 November 2022 up to 31 December 2022.*

- **WHEN WITHDRAWAL NOTICE IS RECEIVED AFTER 1 JANUARY 2023 FOR STUDENTS NOT RETURNING, ONE (1) FULL TERM'S TUITION FEES WILL BE PAYABLE.**
